

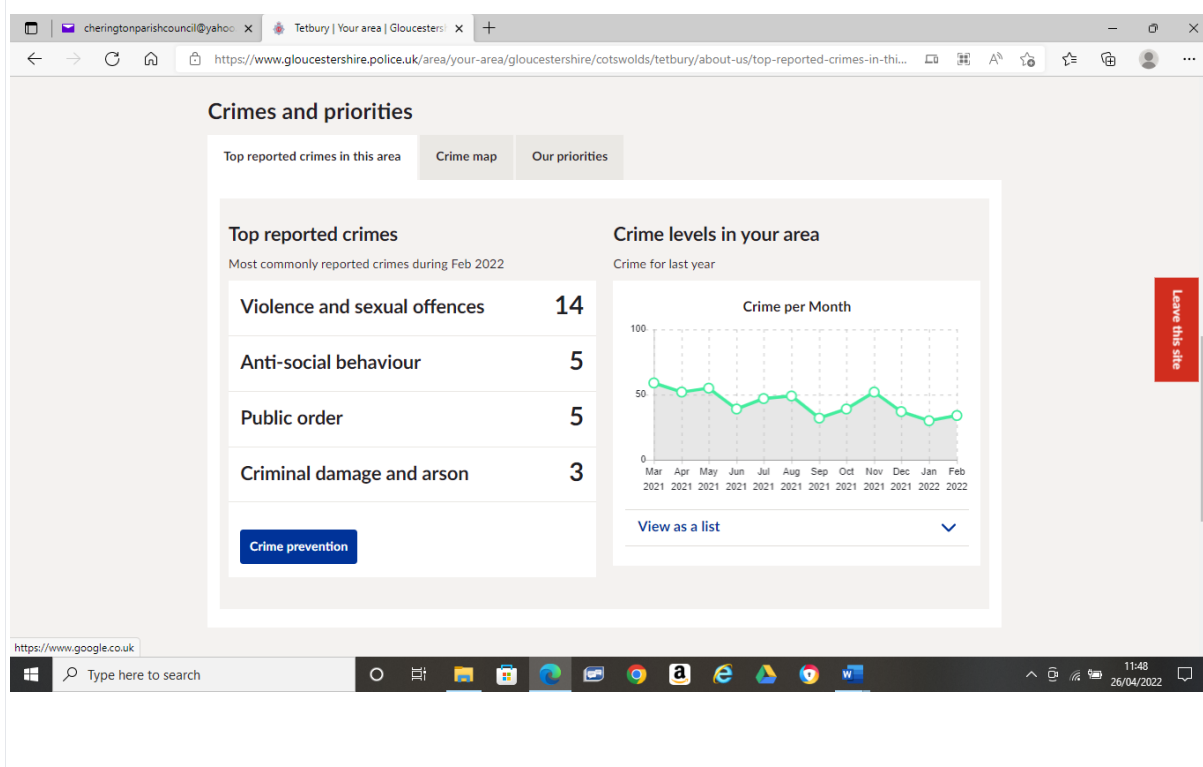
Gloucestershire Crime Statistics

Gloucestershire is among the top 10 safest counties in England, Wales, and Northern Ireland. The overall crime rate in Gloucestershire in 2021 was 52 crimes per 1,000 people, and the most common crimes were violence and sexual offences, which happened to roughly every 24 out of 1,000 residents.

Out of all of Gloucestershire's larger towns and cities, Stroud is the most dangerous. The next most dangerous is Filton, and Patchway comes in as third most dangerous. There are safer parts of Gloucestershire, starting with Bitton, which ranks as the safest area in Gloucestershire, followed by Charlton Kings in second place and Dodington in third place.
